Aurukun State School will receive

\$275,477*

This funding will be used to

- Continue the development of the Wik Mungkan language program to build on the knowledge base of our local community staff members, develop and resource learning programs and further consultation with the Language Advisory Group.
- Strengthen Positive Behaviour for learning (PBL) across the school, build staff capacity in classroom management as we work towards creating a culture that promotes learning. Further develop the role and purpose of The Wellbeing Room.

Our initiatives include

- Collaboratively developing unit plans with our language team, a Linguist, Head of Curriculum, community experts and Regional Office.
- By the end of 2021 all primary students will be engaged in weekly language lessons.
- Continue to provide opportunities for our language team to learn about the operation of similar successful programs in schools offering traditional language programs.
- Further develop teacher capacity in the importance of language in the classroom and working with their teacher aide and the use of Wik Mungkan in engaging students.
- An explicit process in the re-engagement of students in learning and their induction and transition to be supported by the Wellbeing Room/Staff.
- Continue a twice-yearly school wide profiling sweep with an increase in teachers ability to manage universal classroom behaviours.
- Provide training opportunities for all staff in Positive Behaviour for Learning and Zones of Regulation.
- Provide coaching to all teachers around successful classroom management and engagement.
- Developing proactive programs for identified Tier 2 and Tier 3 students through various programs and community engagement.
- Strengthen the work started on the Aurukun State School values and develop explicit behaviour lessons based on our PBL matrix taught weekly in all classrooms.
- Introduce a structured awards program for positive behaviours in the classroom and playground.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing a Linguist to support planning of units and resource development \$ 90,000
- Resourcing the Wik Mungkan Language program and providing PD opportunities \$ 25,000
- Employment of an additional T/A for the Wik Mungkan Language Program to develop capabilities. \$26,477
- Employ a HoD – Student Wellbeing and Classroom Management to coach teachers and lead improvement work around PBL, student wellbeing programs, transition/induction of new students and fully implement the values and reward system. \$119,000
- Resourcing Student Wellbeing room and wellbeing programs \$ 15,000
