HOMEWORK POLICY

Every child has homework every night of the week. At Tanduringie State School, this homework in each year level consists of:

- o Home reading
- o Spelling
- o Maths
- o Assignments and/or investigations when and where appropriate

All of the above components of homework will be targeted and differentiated at the individual student's level and will be closely monitored by class teachers.

With this homework expectation in place it is anticipated that all students from prep to year 6 should be able to complete the three tasks detailed above within 30 minutes each day.

Access to the internet and computers for investigations, research and assignments for those students who require them is readily arranged with class teachers.

Teachers ensure clear expectations to parents and students are sent home early in the year so that students and families are aware of what is expected.

High standards of bookwork and handwriting are expected just as they are in daily class work.

Homework is important to develop good study habits and give parents an indication of their child's progress. Parents are asked to assist by reminding students of their responsibility to do their homework, by testing set spelling and listening to reading. Any uncertainties about individual class homework expectations should initially be directed to class teachers.
